3. *The completed application on the reverse and all supporting documents must be received at IPMA-HR headquarters, 1617 Duke St., Alexandria, VA 22314, by June 5, 2009.*

The minimum requirements and the criteria for the Fellowship include the following:


1. A minimum of five years of full-time professional experience of excellent quality and depth. At least two of these years must be in an HR-related area.
2. A strong academic record.
3. Demonstrated leadership, management or creativity.
4. Strong commitment to public sector human resources.
5. Current national membership in the Association of at least one year, other than as a student member.
6. Participation in IPMA-HR at the chapter, regional, section and/or national level.

2009 IPMA-HR Graduate Study Fellowship

An innovative educational opportunity!

The Graduate Study Fellowship offered by the International Public Management Association for Human Resources (IPMA-HR) allows recipients to pursue graduate study in public administration, business administration, the law or a related field. In 2008, IPMA-HR will award up to \$2,000 to each of two individuals seeking graduate degrees in the aforementioned fields. The Fellowship is renewable for a maximum of one academic year, subject to evidence of maintaining grades of B or better or a GPA of 3.0 or better. During the second year, fellowship recipients must remain a member of the Association. **Ph.D. candidates are not eligible for the Graduate Study Fellowship.**

This is a chance “not-to-be-missed” for eligible IPMA-HR members who have decided to continue their education. All eligible members are encouraged to apply.
