

2020 IPMA-HR College Scholarship Application

The Association shall provide up to two (2) scholarships for \$1,000 each, for a full-time academic year or equivalent, for the children/step-children/legal guardian of IPMA-HR members, who are pursuing a bachelor's degree at an accredited college or university. Preference will be given to individuals who are pursuing a degree in public administration or business administration which include an HR-related concentration. This scholarship is not renewable. For purposes of this scholarship, a full-time academic year or equivalent shall be considered 30 undergraduate credit hours. Part-time students are eligible, but the award shall be on a pro rata basis.

All applications will be reviewed for eligibility. To be considered, applicants must meet the following minimum requirement: must have a parent, step-parent, or legal guardian who has been a current national IPMA-HR member (other than a chapter affiliate member or a student member) for at least the past three years. **This is a one-time scholarship and those who have received it are ineligible from applying again.**
